■ Inter BEE 2021 Online Exhibition Regulations

1. Qualifications for Exhibiting

Corporations and other entities related to the following categories are eligible to exhibit at Inter BEE 2021.

- (1) Equipment manufacturers
- (2) Component, device, and material manufacturers
- (3) Broadcasting and communications companies
- (4) Software and content production companies
- (5) Trading and distribution companies
- (6) Service companies
- (7) Publishers of newspapers, magazines, etc.
- (8) Educational and research institutions
- (9) Government agencies, administrative corporations, public interest corporations, non-profit corporations, public organizations, industry organizations

※Exhibiting through an advertising agency is not permitted even if the exhibitor is a corporation that handles the above categories.

2. Application and Contract

Please fill out the "Online Exhibition Application and Contract Form" and send it to contact@inter-bee.com by e-mail. The exhibition application and contract will be completed when the Japan Electronics Show Association (JESA) notifies you of its acceptance. The date indicated in the confirmation of acceptance shall be the date of conclusion of the exhibition contract, and the exhibitor shall be obliged to pay the exhibition fee.

3. Exhibition Categories, Exhibition Fees, Payment, Cancellation, Reduction

(1) Exhibit Category

- Pro Audio Division
- Visual Expression/Pro Lighting
- Video production/broadcasting related equipment
- ICT / Cross-media

(2) Exhibition Fees

a. Exhibitor Details Page	JPY 880,000 (incl. Tax)
b. Exhibitor Seminar	JPY 440,000 (incl. Tax)
c. Package Plan (a+b)	JPY 1,100,000 (incl. Tax)

(3) Payment of the exhibition fee

The exhibition fee must be paid by bank transfer to the designated bank account by the following deadline upon request from the Japan Electronics Show Association. (The designated account will be provided upon request.) The exhibitor is responsible for bank transfer fees.

(4) Deadline for payment of the exhibition fee:

Thursday, September 30, 2021

(5) Cancellation of application and reduction of exhibition fee

In the event that an exhibitor cancels the application or reduces the exhibition fee due to a change in circumstances, the following cancellation fee will be charged. Consumption tax will be added to the cancellation fee.

After Friday, October 1st, 2021 100% of the Exhibition Fee

4. Expenses other than the exhibition fee

All expenses other than the exhibition fee must be paid by bank transfer to the designated bank account by the following deadline upon request from the Association or its affiliates (the designated account will be provided upon request). The exhibitor will be responsible for bank transfer fees.

Deadline for payment of all fees other than the exhibition fee Friday, December 24th, 2021

5. Prohibited items and notes when exhibiting

5-1. Prohibited Actions

- (1) Subleasing, selling, transferring, or exchanging of booth space
Exhibitors are prohibited from subleasing, selling, transferring, or exchanging part or all exhibition space, regardless of whether the other party is another exhibitor or a third party.
- (2) Exhibiting for the purpose of collecting personal information
Exhibiting for the purpose of collecting personal information from visitors without exhibiting or promoting any products and services is prohibited. All exhibitors are requested to comply with the requirements of the Personal Information Protection Law. The details to be observed regarding the collection, handling and use of visitors' personal information will be announced separately.

5-2. Responsibilities of the Exhibitor

- (1) Responsibility of payments
Exhibitors will be responsible for payment of the exhibition fee and other expenses invoiced by the Association until payment is completed.
- (2) Compliance with laws and regulations
Each exhibitor shall comply with the laws and regulations of Japan.

5-3. Cancellation or shortening due to force majeure

- (1) If it becomes extremely difficult to hold the exhibition online due to a force majeure, the organizer may cancel the exhibition or shorten the date or time of the exhibition, even before or during the exhibition. In such cases, the organizer will notify exhibitors immediately after making the decision and announce it on the website. The organizer, the Organizing Committee, and the Association will not be held liable for any damages incurred by exhibitors resulting from such decisions or actions.
- (2) If the entire exhibition is cancelled due to force majeure prior to the opening of the exhibition, the Association will return the balance of the exhibition fee to the exhibitor after deducting necessary expenses to be reimbursed.
- (3) If the date or time of the exhibition is shortened due to force majeure, the exhibition fee will not be returned.
- (4) No compensation will be made for expenses incurred by exhibitors due to the cancellation or shortening of the exhibition due to force majeure.

5-4. Copyright and Image Rights

- (1) The content of each exhibitor's page is the property of the exhibitor.
- (2) Exhibitors are requested to take appropriate measures to protect their copyrights and image rights when posting videos or playing audio/video recordings. (This is not required for content for which the exhibitor has the rights and for which the rights have already been handled separately.) For more information on copyrights, please contact the Japan Music Rights Association (JASRAC).

6. Issues concerning published content

6-1. Prohibit the posting of counterfeit or imitation products.

- (1) It is prohibited to display, distribute, or show products (so-called counterfeit or imitation products) that infringe on the intellectual property rights of third parties. (Including, but not limited to, patent rights, trademark rights, design rights, and copyrights, as well as rights of a foreign country).
- (2) If the Executive Committee or the Association deems that any product or service to be published on the Website falls under the category of counterfeit or imitation products, the item will be suspended at its discretion. The exhibitor shall not object to such action.
- (3) Exhibitors are requested full cooperation with the Executive Committee or the Association in investigating whether the products listed on the Website are counterfeit or imitation products.
- (4) Exhibitors shall be responsible for resolving any disputes related to intellectual property rights of the listed products.

6-2. Comparative Labeling

When making comparative displays of products, goods, and technologies of other companies, the permission of the relevant company shall be obtained, and the displays shall be made in a manner that does not cause trouble to other companies. The organizer, the Executive Committee, and the Association will not compensate exhibitors for any losses incurred from such request. If it is judged that sufficient measures have not been taken in response to requests for improvement, the exhibitor may be refused entry to the next exhibition.

7. Violations of regulations and questionable interpretations/ Other / Operating Committee

7-1. Violation of the regulations and questionable interpretation

The exhibitor may not be allowed to exhibit, if they violate the regulations, doubt about the interpretation of the regulations, is determined that the exhibitor will have a negative impact on visitors (web viewers) or other exhibitors, or is determined that the exhibitor is inappropriate, either before or after the acceptance of the application or conclusion of the exhibition contract. The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse participation in Inter BEE 2021 regardless of whether the application has been accepted, the contract has been signed, or the exhibition is still in progress. Interpretation of the above regulations will take precedence over the Japanese regulations.

- (1) If the Executive Committee determines that an exhibitor has violated the Exhibition Regulations, the Association will request the exhibitor to take corrective action.
- (2) If no improvement is made after the above (1) request has been made twice, or if any question arises regarding the interpretation of these regulations, the Executive Committee will discuss the matter and order the exhibitor to take corrective action based on its final decision. The conclusions reached through these consultations will be final, and exhibitors will not be able to file an objection or claim for compensation for damages.
- (3) Exhibitors who have been ordered to make improvements in accordance with (2) above must immediately submit a written report to the Association outlining the details of the improvements and the schedule for implementing them.
- (4) If an exhibitor who has received a request for improvement as described in (2) above does not take the necessary measures as described in (3) above, or if the improvement is deemed insufficient by the Organizing Committee, the following penalties may apply.
 - ① Cancellation of exhibitor information from the following day.
 - ② If an exhibitor fails to comply with the disciplinary action described in ① above, this fact will be made public, and the exhibitor may not be allowed to exhibit at the next Inter BEE.

7-2. Others

- (1) Payment in the form of bills is not acceptable for all expenses including the exhibition fee.
- (2) These regulations are subject to change if deemed necessary by the organizer, the Executive Committee, or the Association. In such cases, exhibitors will be notified of the revised regulations via the Inter BEE 2021 official website or other means.
- (3) Each exhibitor shall comply with the laws and regulations of Japan, and the organizer, the Executive Committee and the Association shall bear no responsibility whatsoever for any violation of laws and regulations made by the exhibitor.

7-3. Executive Committee

The Executive Committee is a body composed of representatives of exhibitors that deliberates and decides on matters related to the management of the exhibition, including regulations and planning.
